#### **Problem:**

Under the Anti Ragging and Women Security cell established in college, the member of the cell find complaint of first year student reported being bullied by a group of seniors during a cultural event.

### **Action & Solution**

Conducted a thorough investigation, including interviews with the student and witnesses. The accused students were identified as members of the senior batch. Facilitated a mediation session







where the accused were made to understand the impact of their actions, and they issued a public apology to that student.

#### **Problem:**

Under the Anti Ragging and Women Security cell established in college, the member of the cell find that several students expressed concerns about inappropriate comments and harassment in the women's hostel, particularly during late-night gatherings by the other students.

#### **Action & Solution**

Organized an awareness workshop on harassment and respectful behavior, specifically targeting hostel residents. Increased supervision by security personnel in hostel common areas, especially during evening hours.

#### **Problem:**

Under the Anti Ragging and Women Security cell established in college, the member of the cell find that a student, Riya Mehta, reported feeling unsafe while walking alone on campus at night, citing a lack of security in poorly lit areas.

#### **Action & Solution**

Enhanced campus security measures by installing additional surveillance cameras in poorly lit areas and increasing the frequency of night patrols. Launched a "Campus Buddy System" encouraging students to pair up when walking on campus at night.

#### **Problem:**

Under the Anti Ragging and Women Security cell established in college, the member of the cell found a complaint of a second year student reported being followed by a stranger while walking outside of campus, causing her significant distress.

#### Action & Solution

The anti ragging and women security cell provided emotional support through counseling to address the distress caused by the situation. Further, detailed information is gathered about the incident and coordinate with campus security to increase surveillance in the area. Also forwarded this issue to the women helpline number. Additionally, we have organized self-defense workshops in collaboration with initiatives like Pink Belt to empower students, to protect themselves. An awareness campaign promoting safety protocols, such as walking in groups and reporting suspicious behavior, is conducted.
